The Computer Entertainment Supplier's Association (CESA; Chairman: Yoichi Wada; location: Minato-ku, Tokyo) determined that the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry Award for significant contribution to the development of the game industry goes to Mr. Tsunekazu Ishihara (the Pokémon Company), the producer of the Pokémon series.

The award ceremony was held yesterday on September 15 on the event stage at the TOKYO GAME SHOW 2011(venue: Makuhari Messe Exhibition Hall 8)

The reasons for selecting Mr. Ishihara are as follows.

- As the producer of Pokémon, for which more than 160 million worldwide of just the game titles of the series alone have been sold, Mr. Ishihara established an enormous market by sublimely developing the series in various formats, starting from game software to movies, TV animation and card games, which are loved by people around the world regardless of generations and borders.
- Mr. Ishihara also showcased fresh ways of playing games by evolving the Pokémon series from individual gaming to gaming which allows friends and even the world to play together. Through his producing ability and business model of brand management, he widened possibilities to draw on the attractiveness of the game to the fullest extent.

[Brief Biography of Mr. Tsunekazu Ishihara]

1983: graduated from the University of Tsukuba with a master's in Art and Design. Worked on development of various game software as a Game Producer.

1995: founded Creatures Inc.

1996: produced "Pokémon Red and Green," which became the origin of the Pokémon series later on. Then worked on every Pokémon software title as a Producer. Inspired to develop Japan's first trading card game "Pokémon Card Game."

1998: founded the Pokémon Center Company (now The Pokémon Company) and became Representative Director concurrently.

Currently, responsible for Brand Management of the entire Pokémon series including video games, card games, TV animation and movies at The Pokémon Company.

The Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry Award was created in 2008 with sponsorship from the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, which is the only award to recognize an "individual" who from the results of a work created and announced in recent years has been evaluated as having made a great contribution to the growth and the development of the Japanese home-use video game industry. Every year, selection is conducted with careful screenings by the Japan Game Awards Selection Committee (Chairman: Takeshi Yoro, Professor Emeritus at the University of Tokyo and Professor at Kitasato University).
