Computer Entertainment Supplier's Association (CESA)

Japan Game Awards 2019 (JGA 2019), organized by the Computer Entertainment Supplier's Association (CESA; Chairman: Hideki Hayakawa), has selected the winners for the Games of the Year Division worthy of representing the year. Super Smash Bros. Ultimate (Nintendo Co., Ltd.) has received the most prestigious Grand Award.

Nintendo Labo (Nintendo Co., Ltd.) has received the Special Award.

Titles eligible were from April 2018 to the end of March 2019, making it truly the last Japan Game Awards Games of the Year Division of Japan's Heisei era. The winners are listed below.



The newest in the *RED DEAD REDEMPTION* series, which has been a hit worldwide. It received overwhelming support from fans globally who had waited for its release and was selected for this award.
