Mr. Masahiro Sakurai (President of Sora Ltd.), the head of the jury, gave the following reasons for the award:

It is an extremely unique work, and I hesitate to describe the characteristics of the game.

The genre is a card game, but the story takes unexpected turns due to the setting, atmosphere creation, and strange metafiction. It is definitely a game that gives off a unique character, and yet it is very enjoyable to play. The award received much support from the panel of judges. If this is the first time you've heard of the game, you are very lucky. We recommend that you play the game without researching its contents or obtaining any advance information.

Inscription invites you on a dark journey that mixes roguelike deck-building, escape-game style puzzles, and psychological horror with blood. But the cards are inscribed with a secret far darker than that....
